

Arini Announces Pricing of €403.7 Million European CLO VI

Sixth European transaction brings total European CLO AUM to \$3.4bn

London, UK – July 7, 2025 – Arini, a leading alternative credit manager with approximately \$10 billion in assets under management, today announces the successful issuance of Arini European CLO VI, a €403.7 million new-issue Collateralized Loan Obligation (CLO).

The transaction received strong demand across the capital structure, including from a number of new investors, and achieved tight pricing across its AAA tranche of Euribor + 132bps in line with top-tier prints. As with previous transactions, Arini European CLO VI will invest primarily in a diversified portfolio of European broadly syndicated senior-secured loans.

The pricing of Arini European CLO VI, which follows only four months on from Arini European CLO V, is a clear demonstration of the firm's ability to maintain momentum and continuously meet institutional demand. The platform is overseen by Mehdi Kashani, Head of Structured Credit, while Ben Rothberg, European CLO Portfolio Manager, is responsible for portfolio management.

Arini's European CLO platform, in conjunction with the recent issuance of Arini US CLO I in March 2025, now brings total global CLO AUM to \$3.36bn. Arini's CLO investment approach combines fundamental credit analysis, supported by the firm's experienced global team of sector analysts, with strong quantitative and risk processes.

Mehdi Kashani, Head of Structured Credit at Arini, said: "We are pleased to see new investor demand as we progress with scaling the platform. This continued growth and momentum is a testament to the talent and quality of our team, and the relationships we've built throughout our core investor base."

"Arini's CLO strategy reflects our complete and multi-dimensional view of European credit markets combined with our fundamental research approach and ability to effectively assess risk-return profiles," added Hamza Lemssouguer, Founder and Chief Investment Officer at Arini. "We remain committed to building the platform to become the issuer of choice for global institutional investors."
